Dear Parents,

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for making me feel so welcome this term. Well done to Miss Zarandi for adding some pizzazz into the choreography but most importantly thank you to our Key Stage 2 pupils for putting Christ back to the centre of our thoughts this Christmas.

Many of the pupils then went to the INTU centre on Thursday evening to share their fabulous singing with the masses. This helped raise funds for Oxfam. The children were a credit as always as was our super Mrs Simpson who was on hand to guide them as always.

The school disco which FOSH organised on Friday was a real success and enjoyed by all who attended. Thank you to those who were involved in organising it and to the parents and staff who helped at the event too. This week has been equally fun as we have been entertained by Zoltan Koffer and our pupils who performed a show case of their talents on Monday afternoon in assembly. This morning Mrs CC led a wonderful assembly with the help of Year 6 and Mr Longman where they used puppets to tell the story of Mary. The audience was captivated. Then later the whole school, dressed in their finery with Christmas hats to boot, enjoyed a lovely Christmas dinner which was served by our brilliant staff.

I would like to end this term by informing you that we have received our RE Inspection back. For this Inspection you receive two separate grades. One for the Teaching and learning of RE and the other for the Catholic Life of the school. I am delighted to announce that we received a **GOOD** grading for the RE curriculum and an **OUTSTANDING** grade for the Catholic Life of Sacred Heart. There are one or two minor factual inaccuracies in the report so we are waiting for these to be changed before we can share the finished document with you. We will publish this early in the New Year and will evaluate some of the findings more. What we are so very proud of is how glowingly our pupils came through. To me this is the number one, most important aspect because if we have happy children then I know they will succeed.

We regularly teach our pupils about E-Safety and what to do if something inappropriate comes up. This is a topic I feel passionately about and something where I would like to facilitate a meeting for parents so that we are all aware of the sites that are suitable and those which may look like they are but are not! Please take the time to read this and discuss with your child what they should do if they experience being exposed to something online outside of school.
