Weekly Reminders

RE

This Sunday is the First Sunday of Advent. Each day one of you will read a different prayer at the start of the day. Your homework this week is to write an Advent prayer which can be read in class. You need a plain piece of paper folded in half. Inside you need to write an Advent prayer showing that you understand what it means to be a Catholic Christmas person (this is follow-up work from class). On the outside you need to draw a picture which shows that you know symbols of Advent. This will form a large display on the RE board in the classroom (an Advent calendar) and each day we will open at least one door and you will read out your prayer.

Reading

2. You should have the username and password for the online reading program **ReadTheory**. This week you need to complete activities. As with anything online, if you are concerned about anything then tell an adult.
