RE and Handwriting

Citizenship and PSHE

On Monday we shall hold our elections for Class Council (School Council) and Eco Council. Your task this week must be completed for Thursday.

There are two options:

1. If you are standing for election for either the Eco Council or School Council, prepare a short speech which sets out why you would be a good choice for the role you are going for. What qualities do you have? What would make you better at this job than someone else? In Year 6 you can stand for election on the School Council even if you have been on it before.
2. If you are not standing for election then you need to decide what qualities you would want from your Class Council or Eco Council Representative. Write a list of at least 5 qualities that you would have in the job description. We will share these in class.

Reading

1. You should be reading your own reading book independently at home.
2. Read Hungry world Sponsored Walk, answer all 5 questions and then complete the Find Out Yourself either by doing some research or talking at home.

If there is any vocabulary that you are unsure of, make a note of it and try to look it up.
