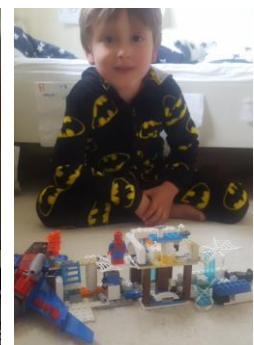

Amy dressed up last weekend on what would have been her First Holy Communion day. Her cousin Amber made her an amazing two-tier communion cake.



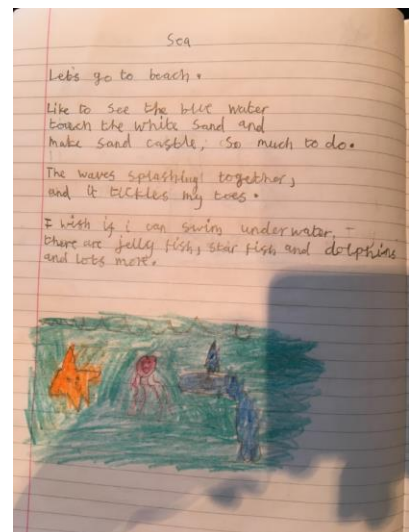
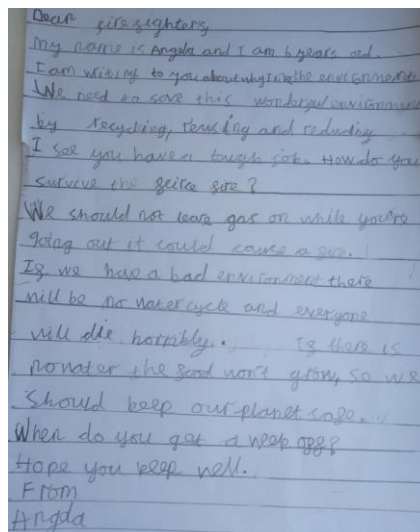
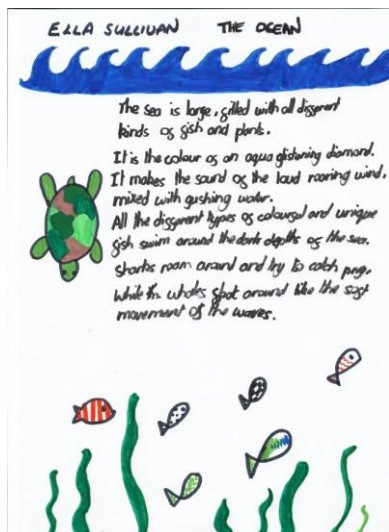
