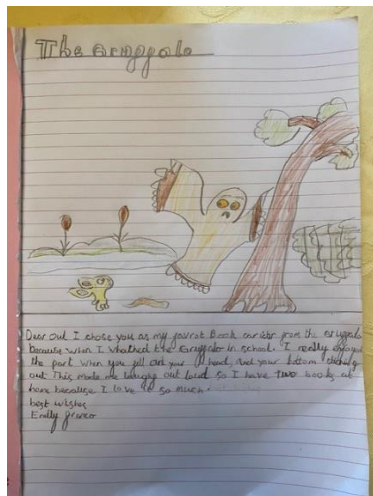
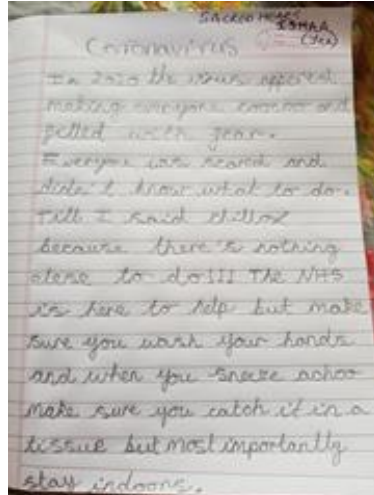
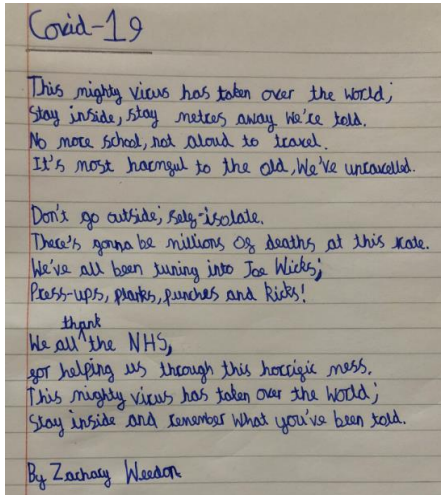
Mrs O'Connor's Den Building Challenge
